



Portfolio Results

The third quarter's mixed economic news and the Fed's first rate cute in four years brought, paradoxically, both the return of market volatility and new stock market highs. Despite two modest drawdowns in the quarter, the S&P 500 is up 22% this year, the best first nine months of a year since 1997.

The Socially Responsible Investment Fund (SRIF) posted a strong gain of 6.6% in the third quarter and a robust return of 26.0% over the trailing one-year. The SRIF remains committed to a diversified asset allocation, consistent with its long-term investment horizon.

Gospel Value Priorities

The SRIF incorporates the top socially responsible investing (SRI) and gospel value priorities identified via dot voting at 2014 Convention, and most recently affirmed and expanded in 2017. These values encompass both positive investment and divestment. The Committee recognizes that, in isolation, each investment may not address all of the gospel value priorities, but the SRIF in whole will emphasize these priorities.
